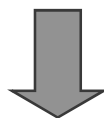

Statement: Disclosure of Potential Conflict of Interest

All presenters of oral and poster presentations must disclose any actual or apparent conflict of interest related to the content of their presentation. Delegates, attending supported educational meetings must be made aware of any potential biases a presenter may have in the presentation of the material, thus allowing delegates to properly evaluate the content of the presentation.

In order to inform delegates attending such meetings, the organising committee requires that all presenters disclose any involvement with industry that may potentially influence the presentation of their material.

Potential Conflict of Interest must be made known to the organising committee at the time of acceptance of an invitation to present an oral presentation or on submission of an abstract for consideration for an oral or poster presentation.

It is the sole responsibility of the individual speaker/presenter to make such disclosure at the time of the presentation. Presenters who have no involvement with industry should inform the delegates that they have no conflict of interest to disclose.

Disclosure may be done verbally, by using a slide at the beginning of a presentation or in written form by a statement at the end of a poster presentation
